Summary of Position

For service hours, students can count driving to the grocery store, time at grocery store, making kits or desserts at home then driving to our center as hours.

Volunteer from Home Opportunities

- Host a clothing or move-in kit drive. Encourage your friends to clean out their closets, donate, or pick up some items on their next shopping trip. - **Prepare individually wrapped desserts** to be distributed to our clients. Fruit (oranges and bananas) can also be provided.

We accept clothing and other gently used items. We are not able to accept furniture, electronics, large appliances, children's bicycles, and used mattresses. Items are accepted at the discretion of St. Patrick Center staff. Donations can be dropped off at our Donation Center behind the building. A staff member will greet you at your car. All donations can be dropped off Monday to Friday, 8am to 4pm.
