### Summary of Position

- St. Patrick Center serves over 200,000 meals every year – that’s a lot of casserole. Groups of all sizes can come in to our commercial kitchen or make casseroles from home using one of our recipes. Cook, laugh, and listen to music while creating memories and meals for us to serve. One recipe will create 10 casseroles and provide 100 meals in our community.

### Duties and Responsibilities

- Have your “Casserole Captain” contact us to find a date and time that works for your group
- Choose a recipe and shopping list provide by St. Patrick Center
- Shop alone, with your group, or split up the list to share the cost
- Thoroughly wash hands, wear apron and gloves while handling food
- Use kitchen appliances/utensils as needed to prepare/heat provided food
- Cook and label food using pans and labels provided by St. Patrick Center

### Skills & Attitude

- Respect all agency policies, such as client confidentiality, standards of conduct, etc.

### Dress Code (when preparing at St. Patrick Center)

- No sleeveless shirts or apparel displaying offensive language and/or alcohol marketing, conservative length shorts or skirts, do not wear jeans or pants with holes, closed-toe shoes

### Physical Requirements

- Knowledge of kitchen appliances, proper food handling
- Reaching by extending hands or arms in any direction
- Appropriate communication skills
- Ability to see within normal parameters, handle physical movement and tasks

**Age requirement policy: 18 years old without a chaperone. Please use your best judgment if you choose to bring children to assist in our commercial kitchen.**
